

The tracks in the disk are divided into smaller sections, called sectors. Each track can



Benefits of Cache Memory:

- Cache memory is faster than main memory.
- The access time of cache memory is less than that of main memory.
- It stores programs that can be run in a short interval of time.

Disadvantages of cache memory:

- Storage capacity of cache memory is very small.
- It is very expensive.
